



VALLEY OF THE MOON

The proposed landscape design for Valley of the Moon captures the spirit of its founder George Legler through design that embraces happiness, spirituality, and the imagination. Historical structures and existing vegetation are preserved and enhanced with additional plant materials. The new vegetated areas are planted with desert-adapted species in rainwater harvesting basins, and create new spaces for seating and programming. The proposed vegetation will also allow Valley of the Moon to be a beautiful destination both day and night, which opens opportunities for various types of events. A focus on children resonates through playhouse and slide, a miniature forest, jojoba maze, several specific design elements, including a interesting shadow projections, and a jojoba maze.
